

REGULAR SESSION, APRIL 1, 2019

Commissioner Bolduc opened the meeting at 10:00. Commissioner Bolton, Commissioner Buhler, and the Clerk, Denise Gill were present.

Commissioner Bolton moved to amend the agenda to add EMS Billing and Collections Procedures during the Ambulance District meeting. Commissioner Buhler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

INDIGENT

Commissioner Bolton moved to go into an executive session pursuant to IC§31-874 to consider indigent matters. Commissioner Buhler seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Bolton-Yes, Buhler- Yes, Bolduc-Yes. Assistant Director, Kathy Ball joined the meeting. The board recessed executive session and returned to regular session at 10:15 a.m. Commissioners Bolton and Buhler moved and seconded to deny 4784, 4785, 4764 and approve 4780. Motion carried.

2019 FAIR HOUSING PROCLAMATION

Commissioner Bolton moved to Proclaim April 2019 as Fair Housing Month. Commissioner Buhler seconded the motion. Motion carried. Chairman Bolduc signed the Proclamation.

FAIR HOUSING MONTH PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, April 2019 marks the 51st anniversary of the passage of Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, commonly known as the Federal Fair Housing Act; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Human Rights Commission Act has prohibited discrimination in housing since 1969; and

WHEREAS, equal opportunity for all – regardless of race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status or national origin – is a fundamental goal of our nation, state and Gooding County; and

WHEREAS, equal access to housing is an important component of this goal - as fundamental as the right to equal education and employment; and

WHEREAS, housing is a critical component of family and community health and stability; and

WHEREAS, housing choice impacts our children's access to education, our ability to seek and retain employment options, the cultural benefits we enjoy, the extent of our exposure to crime and drugs, and the quality of health care we receive in emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the laws of this nation and our state seek to ensure such equality of choice for all transactions involving housing; and

WHEREAS, ongoing education, outreach and monitoring are key to raising awareness of fair housing principals, practices, rights and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, only through continued cooperation, commitment and support of all Idahoans can barriers to fair housing be removed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark Bolduc, Chairman of the Board of Commissioner of Gooding County, do hereby proclaim April 2019, to be

FAIR HOUSING MONTH
