AMBULANCE DISTRICT

Barbara Rivers, EMT, presented the December 2023 Monthly Summary. The report reflected 87 Patients Transports, 33 Interfacility Transfers, 25 Refusals/Lift Assists, 24 Cancelled Enroute and 10 Agency Standbys. Prosecutor Misseldine thinks that the EMS crew should not advise a patient to self-transport. Jon Kepler, EMS Director, reported that they should receive their new ambulance in the first quarter of 2025. They are still dealing with repairs on the other Ambulances. Director Kepler wants the oil leak fixed. Barb Rivers passed her paramedic national registry. Commissioner Bolton relayed a compliment she received.

Chairman Bolduc adjourned the Ambulance District at 11:34 a.m. and reconvened the regular session.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Chairman Bolduc recessed the regular session and opened the Board of Equalization at 11:35 a.m. Assessor Baldwin said he needs to get his ratio study closer to 95% but at this time he is good. Chairman Bolduc closed the Board of Equalization for 2023.
