INDIGENT

The board recessed executive session and returned to regular session at 10:27 a.m. Commissioners Buhler and Bolton moved and seconded to deny 5011. Motion carried.

CITY OF WENDELL
BUILDING INSPECTOR AGREEMENT

Commissioner Bolton moved to sign the Building Inspector Agreement with the City of Wendell. Commissioner Buhler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

MINUTES

Commissioner Bolton moved to approve the minutes from February 14, 2022. Commissioner Buhler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE MEETING REPORTS

Commissioner Buhler reported that the Transportation Committee meeting was cancelled. Commissioner Bolton had nothing to report. Commissioner Bolduc reported that they are still accepting applications for the SIRCOMM Director position.

BUILDING INSPECTION ON PERSONAL PROPERTY

Gooding County Building Inspector, Juan Martinez, is putting a manufactured home in the City of Wendell. Commissioner Bolton moved to have the Planning and Zoning Administrator ask Jerome County Building inspector to do the property inspections for Juan Martinez manufactured home. Commissioner Buhler seconded the motion. Motion carried. The inspection fee from Jerome County will be paid by Gooding County not the City of Wendell.

AMBULANCE DISTRICT

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR JOB DESCRIPTION

Director Kepler expressed his desire to have the Assistant Director job description only require an Advanced EMT certification for the position. Deputy Prosecutor, Ira Dillman, stated that Prosecutor Misseldine had concerns with the changes and that the Medical Director should be asked for his considerations on the changes.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
MAGIC VALLEY PARAMEDICS CHEMS

Commissioner Bolton moved to allow Jon Kepler to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with Magic Valley Paramedics CHEMS services. Commissioner Bolduc seconded the motion. Motion carried. Magic Valley Paramedics will have to have their legal department review the changes.

EMS QUARTERS

Director Kepler reported that the urinal at quarters backed up again. They had clean restroom water run in to other rooms of the EMS quarters. Commissioner Bolton suggested posting a sign on the restroom. The heating system in quarters is inadequate, it is very cold in the common room. Commissioner Bolduc stated that the propane bill last month was \$2,700.

AMBULANCE GRANTS

The group discussed the need to look into grants for an ambulance, whereas it takes a year to eighteen months to receive an ambulance. The Commissioners asked Director Kepler to bring in quotes to the next meeting that can be used for the next budget year.

Chairman Bolduc adjourned the Ambulance District at 11:30 a.m. and reconvened the regular session.
