COMMITTEE REPORTS

Commissioner Buhler reported that Southern Idaho Solid Waste is looking at the renewable energy rates that have increased from \$12.00 three years ago. They are looking to see when the current contract will end. With the added funds, this would allow them to look at paying off the third generator Southern Idaho Solid Waste has, plus the trailers. Commissioner Buhler is looking at touring the facility in Utah in May.
