

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF GOODING, STATE OF IDAHO, TO PROHIBIT ANY PERSON FROM DISCHARGING ANY FIREARM, OTHER THAN A SHOTGUN, OF .17 CALIBRE OR GREATER IN ANY AREA OF THE SNAKE RIVER CANYON OR WITHIN 100 YARDS OF THE RIM OF THE SNAKE RIVER CANYON LOCATED IN GOODING COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Gooding, State of Idaho:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm, other than a shotgun, of .17 calibre of greater than .17 calibre on any privately owned land located in Gooding County which is within 100 yards of a rim of, or within the walls of or in the bottom area of, the canyons known as, The Snake River Canyon, without the express written or oral permission of the owner or person in lawful possession or control of said privately owned land.

SECTION 2

Any person guilty of violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not less than fifty (\$50.00) dollars nor more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars. A second violation shall be punishable by a fine of not less than two hundred (\$200.00) nor more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

SECTION 3

This act is hereby declared an emergency and shall take effect immediately.

AFTER DUE CONSIDERATION it was moved by Commissioner Wilkins, and seconded by Commissioner Brailsford that the foregoing Ordinance be approved and adopted as an official act of this Board to be effective upon posting. Chairman LeMoyne put the motion to a vote with all members voting in the affirmative.
