<p align="center">COUNTY COMMISSIONER THIRD DISTRICT 2 Year Term (Vote for One)</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Ron Buhler (REP)</p> <p><input type="radio"/> _____ (WRITE-IN)</p>	<p align="center">SJR 102</p> <p>Legislative Council's Statement of Meaning, Purpose, and Result to Be Accomplished</p> <p>Currently, the Legislature may meet in a special session only upon call of the Governor. The proposed amendment would allow the Legislature to convene itself in special session if 60% of the members in each house submit a petition to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The petition must specify the subjects to be addressed in the special session, and only those subjects could be considered during the special session.</p> <p>The amendment also requires the Legislature to hold an organizational session in December following a general election. The purpose of the organizational session is to prepare for the upcoming regular session. The proposed amendment would formalize in the Idaho Constitution the Legislature's longstanding practice of holding an organizational session.</p> <p align="center">Question</p> <p>"Shall Section 8, Article III, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended to provide that the Legislature must convene in organizational sessions commencing on the first Thursday of December after the general election, unless a different day shall have been appointed by law, and in special session by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than fifteen days following the receipt of a joint written petition of at least sixty percent of the membership of each house specifying subjects to be considered, and to provide that the Legislature shall have no power in such a special session to consider or pass any bills or resolutions on any subjects other than those specified in the petition and those necessary to provide for the expenses of the session?"</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>	<p>Do you approve or disapprove of the State of Idaho using the record budget surplus to refund \$500 million back to hardworking Idaho taxpayers, cut ongoing income taxes by more than \$150 million, and put more money in our classrooms by increasing education and student funding by a record \$410 million?</p> <p>Your approval of this effort would combat historic inflation by returning money to the taxpayers, creating a simple flat tax, and making the single largest investment in public education in Idaho history.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> APPROVE</p> <p><input type="radio"/> DISAPPROVE</p>

The City currently has outstanding long-term indebtedness of \$2,303,494 paid solely from wastewater system revenues. Since the bond will be paid solely from water revenues, there will be no tax authorized on any taxable assessed value.</p>

The total principal amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds is \$4,800,000; the total interest estimated to be paid over the life of the bonds is \$4,113,516; the total amount estimated to be repaid over the life of the bonds is \$8,913,516. The bonds will be payable over a term which may be less than but which will not exceed forty (40) years.</p>
